I feel we should get this on order and updated as the current generator is over 15 years old. If it breaks down the cost of repairs and finding parts could be very costly. We have no standby for an 80 KW unit.
 - H. Schedule adding a generator to the Fire Station, DPW currently sets up a portable unit which needs constant supervision and fueling. With a stand-by unit the fire station could be used as a warming station in the event of a village wide power outage as well as have the building functioning for any emergency in any weather. Chief has requested we move the Grass/rescue rig replacement out another year and use half of the set aside funds in the 23-24 budget for this generator.
