REMEMBER TO KEEP THOSE SIDE-WALKS CLEAR

Sec.28-20. Maintenance. No person shall permit any sidewalk upon property owned by him to fall into a state of disrepair or to be unsafe; nor shall such owner allow snow, ice, sand, gravel or other materials to accumulate upon sidewalk so as to hinder, impede or endanger persons using the sidewalk. This responsibility shall rest exclusively with the respective owner of the property and shall not be the responsibility of the village.
