- A. Resolution 20-21-01; to apply for Transportation Economic Development Fund Category B Program Funding – **Motion** by Squanda, 2nd by Godi to reapply for a \$225,000.00 matching funds for major streets repair. The Funds would be designated to resurface a portion of Center Street.


Miscellaneous: Due to COVID-19, Village office staff is on limited hours. If you need assistance, please call and leave a message, someone will get back with you.
