**Ordinance Sec. 32-93.** No person shall operate an off-road motor vehicle within the village with the following exceptions:

- (1) Said vehicle may be operated in the village during a period of emergency when so declared by the village president or chief of police, when travel by conventional automotive vehicles is not possible.
- (2) Said vehicles may be operated upon private property.
